

Be a part of history! Do your part to support democracy in the Presidential Election of 2008. Over 800 Cumberland County citizens are needed to work at County polls on Election Day, November 4, 2008 and beyond. The Bureau of Elections will provide training and coordinate assignments for those who are interested. Anyone who will be at least 18 years old by the date of the election, and registered to vote, is eligible to be a poll worker.

Each poll worker is paid a minimum of \$115.00 to work on Election Day, \$6.00 to attend training prior to the election, plus round trip mileage to and from that training.
