RECYCLING

Apartment Houses

The Code of the Borough of Shippensburg requires the owner(s) of an apartment house(s), with three (3) or more units, to establish and maintain a recycling program for said building(s). The following sections of the Borough Code address this requirement:

§99-14. Definitions.

APARTMENT HOUSE - Any building housing three (3) or more dwelling units.

§99-15. Removal of recyclables; containers.

B. Furnishing containers. The resident of each housing unit shall be responsible for providing approved containers for the storage of recyclables. **NO** recyclables shall be stored, at any time, in violation of this Article. Apartment houses, commercial and industrial establishments may utilize recycling containers which can be hydraulically emptied into the recycling truck. Said containers shall be purchased from the Borough of Shippensburg.

§ 99-16. Collection.

C. Accumulation of Recyclables. Commercial establishments and industries, including apartments, restaurants, hotels, markets and stores shall provide for the removal of recyclable material as often as shall be necessary to maintain a sanitary and healthful condition; provided, however, that in no event shall removal be less than one (1) time in each period of seven (7) calendar days. Such establishments may utilize for storage large, closed recycling containers, which can be emptied into the recycling truck.

§99-22. Establishment of recycling program.

B. Apartments and Condominiums.

Every owner of an apartment house, with three (3) or more dwelling units, shall provide for recycling through the establishment of a collection system. The system shall provide for the source separation of those items designated recyclable for residential curbside program. Such collection system shall be approved by the Borough Manager or his designee.

ALL Shippensburg Borough residents are required to recycle the following items:



Metal (Bi-Metal and Aluminum Cans), Glass (Clear, Green and Amber), Newspaper, Cardboard, Type 1 and Type 2 Plastics, Mixed Paper (magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, cereal, soda and gift boxes; paper bags, wrapping paper and phone books).

Industrial, Institutional and Commercial units are required to recycle high-grade office paper.

RENTAL LICENSES

Rental licenses are due June 1st of each year. The license application requires a listing of tenants in each rental unit. The Rental License fee is \$15.



Rental Inspections are conducted by Commonwealth Code Inspection

Services (CCIS), on a regular three (3) year cycle. The rental inspection fee is as published in the CCIS Property Maintenance Regulations Fee Schedule.

The current fees are:

One- and two-family dwelling - \$50 each unit

Apartment house - \$50 first unit; \$25 for each additional unit

Hotel - \$160, plus \$5 for each unit over 5 units

Adult care home - \$160, plus \$5 for each unit over 5 units

CCIS will contact each rental property owner to set up an inspection time. Rental inspection fee payment is due prior to the inspection and will be billed by CCIS.


WATER DEPARTMENT NEWS

WATER LINE CONSTRUCTION



The Borough Authority is in the process of constructing a water storage tank on Timber Hill. As part of this project, new water lines will be installed this spring and summer along West King Street, Hostetter Avenue and Possum Hollow Road.

TIMBER HILL WATER TANK



Bids have been awarded for the construction of a water storage tank on Timber Hill. This project will provide storage in the mid-pressure zone. Once completed, all water customers west of the Route 11 railroad bridge (by Pizza Hut) will be converted to the mid-pressure zone and the Forest Ridge pumping station will be deactivated. The project is scheduled to be completed by December 2012.

MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY

The Shippensburg Borough Authority maintains only the following:



Water mains, the tap on the main (corporation stop), and the water meter. All other appurtenances, including the service line under the street, are the responsibility of the property owner. The property owner, at their expense, shall promptly repair all water leaks. In case of an emergency, the repair will be made by the Water Department and a bill sent to the property owner. The definition of "emergency repair" shall be the Water Department's decision.

*Customers are reminded that they **MUST** provide access to the water meter and reading devices. **PLEASE** keep the areas free of debris and clutter.*

MULCH AND COMPOST

Wood chip mulch or screened compost may be purchased Monday through Friday, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Please report to the Wastewater Treatment Plant office to get an operator to load your vehicle. Wood chip mulch is available as we grind it. Sales are on a first-come, first-served basis. There will be special Saturday hours, 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., on the following days:

May 5 and 19
June 2 and 16



CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF TREE/GARDEN WASTE

April 16-20, 2012

The Borough has established the curbside collection of tree/garden waste. Such collection shall occur once in the spring and once in the fall. Collection will coincide with the Borough's trash collection.


1. Items to be collected are leaves, garden residues, shrubbery trimmings, tree trimmings and similar material.



2. Tree trimmings and shrubbery trimmings shall be **NO GREATER** than two (2) inches in diameter and three (3) feet in length, and shall be bundled and tied with twine or cord string only, or placed in a container **NO LARGER** than a 30-gallon trash can.

3. Garden residue and leaves shall be placed in a container such as a 30-gallon trash can(s) or biodegradable bag(s).

4. Absolutely **NO** plastic bags.



5. All containers and/or bundles shall be of a weight that will allow one (1) person to easily lift and empty into the front box of trash truck. In **NO** instance shall the weight exceed 35 pounds.

6. **NO** grass will be collected.

7. Material **MUST** be placed at curbside, **NOT** more than 24 hours prior to collection.

8. Leaves are **NOT** permitted to be raked or blown into the street, except during the week prior to scheduled pickup during fall leaf collection.

VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any person, partnership or corporation violating any provision shall, upon conviction in summary proceedings, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$300 or more than \$1,000 per offense and, in default of the payment of such fine, may be imprisoned for a period of not more than 90 days. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate and distinct offense.




DYKEMAN ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Bids have been awarded for the realignment of Dykeman Road, at South Fayette Street. The project consists of moving Dykeman Road to meet Fayette Street, at Olde Scotland Road, and the installation of traffic signals at the new 4-way intersection. Completion is scheduled for June 30, 2012.



WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Borough is currently preparing plans and specifications for a one (1) million gallon per day expansion of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. As part of this project, the plant will also be converted from biological nutrient removal (BNR) to enhanced nutrient removal (ENR). The ENR process treats to a higher level, which results in cleaner effluent discharged to the stream. The project is scheduled to be advertised in late spring, with construction starting by early fall 2012.
