PROJECTS IN PROGRESS

- The Roxbury Road waterline replacement project is complete.
- The Borough Authority is in the process of constructing a water storage tank on Timber Hill. This will allow for additional safety measures, in the event a failure occurs at a production facility, and improve water pressure on the West End of town.

OWNERSHIP CHANGE REQUIREMENTS

The customer or the customer's agent, of any premises serviced with water, shall notify the Borough Authority not less than three (3) working days prior to the date of any change of ownership of such premises. Final payment from the seller is due at settlement of the change of ownership. Shortly after settlement, the buyer will be sent a Water Contract to complete and sign. Failure to complete the Water Contract will cause the water service to the premises to be disconnected and additional charges levied.



RESIDENTIAL REFUSE

Each residential unit, within the Borough of Shippensburg, is permitted four (4) 32-gallon refuse containers per week. Each container **MUST** be of a size that can easily be handled by one (1) person, with a maximum filled weight, including the container, of 50 pounds. Trash cannot be set out earlier than 24 hours prior to collection and containers **MUST** be removed from collection site within 24 hours after pickup. **NO** loose trash will be picked up. Exterior storage of trash **MUST** be in a container with a tight-fitting lid.

IT'S A VIOLATION WITHIN THE BOROUGH TO.....

- BLOW LEAVES, GRASS, STICKS AND OTHER LAWN REFUSE INTO OR PLACED IN THE STREET, EXCEPT DURING FALL LEAF COLLECTION AND THEN LEAVES ONLY MAY BE PLACED AT THE CURB NO EARLIER THAN ONE (1) WEEK PRIOR TO SCHEDULED COLLECTION. THIS IS TO PREVENT STORM DRAINS FROM BEING BLOCKED.



- PERMIT TREES, SHRUBS, HEDGES OR OTHER VEGETATION TO OVERHANG SIDEWALKS OR OTHER PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS AT A HEIGHT OF LESS THAN 8' FEET MEASURED FROM THE SIDEWALK SURFACE.

- PERMIT TREES, SHRUBS OR OTHER VEGETATION TO OVERHANG A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AT A HEIGHT OF LESS THAN 16' MEASURED FROM THE STREET SURFACE AT THE CURB.

- STORE GARBAGE, GARBAGE CONTAINERS OR TRASH IN FRONT OF A BUILDING, ON A PORCH OR FRONT YARD, EXCEPT FOR 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED COLLECTION.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT NEWS

CURRENT PROJECTS

Treatment Plant staff are currently working on expanding the Wastewater Treatment Plant by one (1) million gallons per day and converting the treatment process from BNR to ENR.

BNR=Biological Nutrient Removal
ENR=Enhanced Nutrient Removal

SNOW/ICE REMOVAL
