SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING GUIDELINES

GLASS



Acceptable Materials

Clear, green and brown bottles and jars

Unacceptable Materials

Window glass, ceramics, ovenware, crystal, mirrors and Pyrex
Light bulbs, glass cook ware, glass mugs, dishes

METALS



Acceptable Materials

Food and beverage containers made of aluminum, steel and tin
Aluminum, tin and steel cans and foils

Unacceptable Materials

Chemical, paint, pesticide and gasoline containers
Hangers, household appliances, pots/pans, hazardous material

PLASTICS



Acceptable Materials

Plastic containers 1-7
Wide mouth containers (yogurt, peanut butter, margarine)
6-pack & 12-pack plastic rings, large rigid plastics
Plastic beverage containers, shampoo & detergent containers

Unacceptable Materials

Oil containers, VCR Tapes, anything food contaminated
No plastic bags, Styrofoam, plastic ware, PVC, CD's/DVD's

PAPER



Acceptable Materials

Paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail
Cardboard, paperboard, cereal boxes, paperboard boxes
Office paper (shredded lengthwise), paper bags, egg cartons
Newspaper (including inserts and brochures)

Unacceptable Materials

Gift wrap, paper towels, tissues
Diced or cross-cut office paper

Getting Started

- 1) Please rinse your glass, metal and plastic recycling materials, as possible.
- 2) Please remove all lids. Lids can be recycled, but must be removed and placed into the container separately.
- 3) Please make sure recycling items are free from food debris, and as dry as possible.
- 4) Please break-down cardboard and flatten plastic bottles as much as possible.
- 5) Please place all acceptable recycling materials into the same recycling container, do not tie or bag.
- 6) Please place your container at the curb, with the lid firmly secured, on your scheduled collection day.
