

RESOLUTION NO. 95-004

REGULATING THE PAYMENT OF WATER BILLS BY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS OF THE SHIPPENSBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY, CUMBERLAND AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES, PENNSYLVANIA

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the SHIPPENSBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY and it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. The SHIPPENSBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY hereby institutes a policy for residential customers of the SHIPPENSBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY regulating water bills in excess of normal bills.
2. Any residential customer, whose water bill for the previous quarter is more than three (3) times the normal water bill, as determined by the average of the prior four (4) quarters, shall request reduction of the charges in writing to the AUTHORITY.
3. The AUTHORITY, may reduce the amount to three times as determined under paragraph two, all other amounts shall be forgiven.
4. This reduction shall be available to residential customers only one time during the period of time they are a customer of the SHIPPENSBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY.
5. This forgiveness shall be available only to individuals meeting income criteria available in the BOROUGH of SHIPPENSBURG.
6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
