*Collection of tree and garden waste will occur once in the spring and once in the fall. The collection will coincide with the Borough's trash collection schedule. Residents are reminded that leaves, grass, sticks and other lawn refuse is not permitted to be blown into or placed in the street except during fall leaf collection and then leaves only may be placed at the **curb no earlier than a week prior to scheduled collection.***

This is to prevent storm drains from being blocked.

Water Service Information: The water department only maintains the water main, the tap on the main and the water meter. All parts of the water line are the responsibility of the property owner including the portion under the road surface.

Leaks: Leaks on the service line are also the responsibility of the property owner and must have repairs done promptly. Any water that passes through the water meter will be billed to the customer. When multiple customers on a single line are discovered it is the property owner that needs to have the problem corrected. This will require a new water service line installation from the water main in the street and to the current Authority standards.

Annual Leak Audit: In the May to June time period the water department will conduct its annual water system leak audit. This audit will discover water leak in the system to help reduce the amount of unaccounted for water.

Street Paving – Tentative Schedule

- S. Washington St... – Orange St. to Walnut St.
- McCreary Ave – Martin Ave to Burd St.
- E Martin Ave. – Penn St. to Queen St.
- W Neff Ave. – S Earl St. to End.
- W Neff Ave. – S Fayette St. to S Morris St.

Snow Removal from Sidewalk...remember to clear sidewalks of snow and ice within 12 hours after the precipitation has stopped falling.

Videoring of sewer lines will be taking place during the spring and fall of 2016. Road detour and noise disturbance will occur but should be minimal.


STREET SWEEPING
