Collection of tree and garden waste will occur once in the Spring and once in the Fall. The Collection will coincide with the Borough's trash collection.

Residents are reminded that leaves, grass, sticks and other lawn refuse is not permitted to be blown into or placed in the street except during fall leaf collection and then leaves only may be placed at the curb no earlier than one week prior to scheduled collection. This is to prevent storm drains from being blocked.

Sales are on a first come, first served basis.



WATER TANK NEWS



The new W. Edward Goodhart water storage tank was placed in service January 2, 2013. This three million gallon capacity tank provides much needed storage for the water System, provides for future development and improves on water pressure on the western side of town.

WATER MAIN FLUSHING

The Borough water department will be flushing water mains during the month of April – May as part of a regular maintenance program to improve drinking water quality for our customers. Residents might notice some discoloration during this program and should be aware this is temporary, normal, and not harmful. If the water in your residence becomes discolored during flushing, run a cold water tap in the bathtub for several minutes until the water clears. Also, if the water is cloudy or discolored, please do not wash laundry to avoid stains. Watch the papers or Borough website for exact flushing schedule.

New Collection Procedures go into effect January 1, 2013.



New Commercial Rates

Effective January 1, 2013 new commercial dumpster rates for refuse material have increased to \$7.50 per yard. This is the first of a three phase increase over the next three years.

New Recycling Rates

Effective January 1, 2013 recycling rates have changed. Most customers there will be NO impact, the \$7.00 per quarter rate remains the same. Customers that have more than one 64 gallon recycling container or are picked up more than once per week, the following rates will apply;

32 Gallon Containers
\$2.00 per qtr/container

64 Gallon Containers
\$3.00 per qtr/container

96 Gallon Container
\$4.00 per qtr/container

WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT NEWS (WWTP)

Progress is going well on the WWTP upgrade. New yard piping has been installed and concrete has been poured for a new clarifier. The WWTP upgrade increases plant capacity from 3.3 to 4.3 million gallons per day and changes the processing from Biological Nutrient Removal (BNR) to Enhanced Nutrient Removal (ENR).

SEWER LINE FLUSHING

The Borough will be flushing sewer lines during the months of May and June as part of a regular maintenance program. All residents will be notified prior to their area being flushed with information on how to prevent toilet overflow. Please watch the newspapers or the access the Borough Website for the exact flushing schedule.
